## ***Closure of northbound Mill Road under bridge delayed to Thursday night***

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission has announced that expected rain tonight has prompted a change in the scheduled bridge work and associated lane closures on Mill Road between Flushing Road and Beecher Road in Flint Charter Township.

The two southbound lanes, which were closed last night, Tuesday, June 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm will remain closed until about 7:30 tonight, Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup> at which time all lanes will be opened. **Then, at about 6:30 pm on Thursday traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes and the two northbound lanes will be closed. The work should be done and Mill Road fully reopened by about 5:00pm Friday June 17<sup>th</sup>.** Motorists are urged to exercise caution at this location.

As construction season kicks into high gear motorists are reminded that the majority of serious and fatal injuries in road work zones are to drivers and their passengers. So please slow down and be extra vigilant in and near all road work zones.
