Gale Road at Coldwater reopened

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission announced this morning that the section of Gale Road in Richfield Township, extending 500' south from the intersection at Coldwater Road, that had been closed to thru traffic the past several days **has been reopened**. Motorists are urged to proceed with caution.

The Seasonal Weight Restrictions that went into effect on Genesee County roads at 6:00 A.M. on Monday March 8th 2010 remain in effect.

This means that, with few exceptions, while these restrictions are in place, the maximum axle load allowable on concrete pavements or pavements with a concrete base are reduced by 25% from the normal maximum axle load, and the maximum axle loads allowable on all other types of roads during these months shall be reduced by 35% from the maximum axle loads as specified.
