## *Lanes closed on Linden Road over Flint River for bridge deck repairs*

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission has announced that they will be doing deck repair work on the bridge on Linden Road over the Flint River, just south of Flushing Road in Flint Charter Township beginning tonight, Monday June 27, 2011 at about 6:30pm. The two southbound lanes will be closed and 2-way traffic shifted to the northbound lanes. Once work is done on this area, traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes and the two northbound lanes will be closed. Electronic message boards are in place to advise motorists. The work is expected to be completed and the road fully opened to traffic by 6:30pm Friday July 1, 2011.

As construction season kicks into high gear, motorists are reminded that **the majority of serious and fatal injuries in road work zones happen in the summer and fall**. So please slow down and be extra vigilant in and near all road work zones.

While GCRC monitors its roads closely, it welcomes calls from the public regarding dangerous conditions such as large potholes or flooding.
