## *Legal load weight restrictions lifted Monday April 5<sup>th</sup> - overweight loads restricted until Friday April 16<sup>th</sup>*

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission announced today that Frost Law weight restrictions for legal loads on all county roads will be lifted effective 6 A.M. Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. **No overweight loads will be permitted** until Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. This means that while legal weights will be allowed on all County roads on April 5<sup>th</sup>, the Road Commission will not issue any permits for overweight loads until Friday April 16<sup>th</sup>.
