MDOT Update: Wilson Road to be closed for epoxy coat of bridge deck

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) has announced they will be closing Wilson Road over I-75 in Vienna Township today for the last time. The closure is needed in order to seal (epoxy flood coat) the concrete bridge deck.

This work only requires the bridge to be closed up to 4 days, barring inclement weather. The epoxy seal is sensitive to moisture so if they encounter any type of rain, the bridge closure will have to be extended.

The detour route for Wilson Road Bridge closure is Linden Road and M-57 (Vienna Road). MDOT anticipates opening the Wilson Road Bridge on Tuesday, September 27th.
