I-75 bridge beam work begins tonight in Flint

COUNTY: Genesee

HIGHWAY: I-75

CLOSEST CITY: Flint

**ESTIMATED

PROJECT: Bridge beam removal and replacement begins tonight at 8 p.m. on two bridges at the following locations:

- Pasadena Road bridge over northbound I-75
- Carpenter Road bridge over northbound I-75

This project will continue Wednesday night at 8 p.m. if not complete on Tuesday night.

**TRAFFIC
RESTRICTIONS:**

Double-lane closures will be in effect, with a single lane open on northbound I-75 from 8 p.m. Tuesday to 7 a.m. Wednesday morning.

Crews will remove and reset the bridge beam on the Pasadena Road bridge first, then move on to complete the same work on the Carpenter Road bridge.

Expect intermittent full closures starting at approximately 10 p.m. Tuesday night while bridge beams are removed and replaced. Single-lane closures will resume at each bridge location as soon as the new beams are in place.

MDOT will use changeable message boards to alert motorists to traffic stops and lane restrictions.

CUSTOMER BENEFIT: This work is part of the \$10 million bridge rehabilitation project on I-75 from I-69 to the Genesee/Saginaw county line; all work is scheduled to be complete by August.

These improvements will increase traffic safety and improve the overall condition of the highway.
