MDOT overpass update: Mt. Morris Road over I-75 to be closed Thursday

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) reports that Mt. Morris Road bridge over I-75 will be closed beginning Thursday, July 28, 2011 at 8:00 p.m. Message boards are in place informing of the upcoming closure. MDOT expects the bridge to be closed to through traffic for about 3 weeks.

The posted REVISED detour for the closure is as follows: westbound Mt. Morris Road traffic will go southbound Clio Road to westbound Stanley Road to northbound Linden Road.

Eastbound Mt Morris Road traffic will go southbound Linden Road to eastbound Stanley Road to northbound Clio Road.

Motorists are again reminded that **work zone crashes are devastating to all concerned: drivers, passengers, workers, families and friends.** So please slow down and be extra vigilant in and near all road work zones.

While GCRC monitors its roads closely, it welcomes calls from the public regarding dangerous conditions such as large potholes or flooding.
