MDOT traffic update: Work on I-475 and bridges progressing

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission is forwarding the following information from the Michigan Department of Transportation as a courtesy to them and to motorists in Genesee County.

“One lane of SB I-475 was opened last night from I-69 to the I-475/I-75 interchange. Portable changeable message boards stating this update are up.

Bristol Road ramp to SB I-475 was also opened, as well as the SB I-475 ramp to Hill Road.

There might be some detour signing still up, but they will either be covered or removed. The rest of the ramps soon will be opened as work gets completed.

There will still be intermittent lane closures on both directions of I-475 from I-69 south until this project is completed. This project should be wrapped up by the end of July.

There is also an active bridge project on I-475 north of I-69. There will still be lane closure(s) or lane shifts on I-475. This bridge project is scheduled to be completed by the end of October.

These dates and times are subject to change in case of inclement weather. As these projects get completed, we will be sending out additional updates, so keep reading these construction updates and the message boards for up-to-date closures.
