Public Meeting/Open House/Input Session - Jennings Road Reconstruction

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission has announced that a public meeting, open-house and input session for the reconstruction of Jennings Road Reconstruction from Pasadena Avenue to Pierson Road will be held on **February 7, 2012 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Mt. Morris Charter Township Government Center**, located at 5447 Bicentennial Drive, Mt. Morris, Michigan. The purpose of the meeting is to share information and get public input regarding the proposed reconstruction of Jennings Road from a 4 lane to a 3 lane roadway. The agenda will be an informal "Open House" with proposed maps, plans, costs and study reports available for public review. Comments from the public will be recorded. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

The project is presently being designed. Actual construction work will begin in May 2012, with the goal of being completed by September 2012. The road will be open to thru traffic during construction with at least one lane open in each direction.

Reconstruction of this heavily traveled corridor is expected to cost over \$1,200,000. It is being funded primarily with federal 2012 Surface Transportation funds administered through the Michigan Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration and the Genesee County Road Commission.

This open house and input session complies with the intent of the Michigan Operations Manual D-121 for projects proposing to convert 4-to-3 lane roadways using Federal Aid transportation funds through the Michigan Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration.
