## **US-23 and I-75 Exit Ramps to be closed for milling and repair Thursday and Friday**

Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission, in conjunction with the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) announces that on Thursday morning, September 15th beginning at 8:00 AM, the Northbound US-23 exit ramp onto Owen Road (Exit 78) in Fenton will be closed for pavement milling. On Thursday afternoon the Northbound I-75 exit onto Bristol Road (Exit 116) in Flint will be closed intermittently for pavement milling. Both of these ramps will be open Thursday night.

Also, on the morning of Friday, September 16th beginning at 8:00 AM, the left two lanes of the Southbound US-23 exit ramp to Owen Road in Fenton will be closed intermittently for pavement milling. The entrance ramps from Owen Road to Southbound US-23 will be closed intermittently Friday afternoon.
