Work on Corunna Road and other overpasses to begin

Flint, Michigan. ---

In an effort to keep motorists better informed the **Genesee County Road Commission** is please to forward this information from the **Michigan Department of Transportation** regarding work on the Corunna Road overpass and other overpasses in Genesee County.

M-21 (Corunna Rd) from I-75 easterly to Miller Rd in the city of Flint (25081-46973a)

Starting Monday April 25th, the contractor will be onsite setting up traffic control. This includes a portable changeable message board on each side of the project to notify traffic of the upcoming and ongoing road work (2 message boards total).

The first lane closures will occur on Monday, May 2nd. There will be periodic lane closures on both EB and WB M-21 between I-75 easterly to Miller Rd. A minimum of one lane in each direction shall remain open for the life of the project.

Sidewalk and curb work will begin May 10th. Once the contractor completes the sidewalk and curb work, they will begin coldmilling and paving M-21. This should occur after the 4th of July holiday.

Also, there may be periodic nighttime lane closures throughout the life of the project.
