Subject: Miller Road over I-75 work

The work for Miller Road over I-75 is starting. This Friday night weather permitting, we will close 2 southbound lanes of I-75 starting at about 9PM. Then traffic will be shifted onto the ramp for I-69 and then southbound I-75 traffic will get back onto I-75 south of the Miller Road bridge using that ramp. The lanes should be opened back up around 9AM on Saturday. During this work the ramp from Miller Road to southbound I-75 will be closed. The detour will be to take northbound I-75 up to M-21 (Corunna Road) and come back onto southbound I-75.

On the same night the left lane of northbound I-75 will be closed around 11PM and will reopen on Saturday morning around 9AM.

Then on Saturday night again around 9PM 2 lanes of southbound I-75 will be closed with traffic shifted onto the ramp for I-69 and back onto I-75 after Miller Road, until about 9AM on Sunday. Again the ramp from Miller Road to southbound I-75 will be closed during this work.

Lane closures should not be needed on northbound I-75 the second night.

All the work is weather dependent. If it does not work out the work moved to the following night.
