#### MANAGING DIRECTOR REPORT

<u>COVID-19 Update</u> – Human Resource Director Ms. Donna Poplar updated the Board on the current COVID-19 cases at the GCRC. Currently she said we have had 16 employees testing positive with the virus. Of those 16, only one employee is out on extended leave (6 months) due to the virus. Ms. Poplar stated that 68 out of 150 of our employees have been affected by COVID-19, either testing positive or having to quarantine due to contact with someone that did

test positive. In addition, IT Manager Mike Lewis will be adding vaccine questions to the COVID-19 worksheet questionnaire that employees fill out every morning. This vaccine information is strictly voluntary and will be held in strict confidence. The GCRC does not currently require employees to be vaccinated and we are merely tracking this information for the local county health department. Commissioner Dickerson asked Ms. Poplar what percentage of employees have been vaccinated. Ms. Poplar stated that we do not have an exact number but said it is safe to say that a large number of employees have been vaccinated. Commissioner Lane added that she does not understand why people do not get the vaccine and asked if the Human Resource department can counsel those employees that are not vaccinated. Ms. Poplar stated that we are not a medical facility so we cannot counsel employees but we recognize that some employees may be fearful of getting the vaccine.

<u>Diversity Training</u> – Ms. Donna Poplar commented that we would be having diversity training this year for the employees covering the topic of systemic racism. In the past Ms. Poplar explained, we have held the training in September and we have reached out to a number of groups to try to get a program together. Ms. Poplar explained that employees working as a team help individuals work together regardless of the color of their skin. We need to face reality that there are some people here that are racist and we need to work on that as an organization with an emphasis on teamwork.

### **COMMISSIONERS' CONCERNS**

Adopt a Highway Program - Commissioner Lane said she has noticed numerous groups picking up and bagging debris from the roads and highways and added that they provide a valuable resource to the community. Ms. Lane wishes that there were a way to tell them that they are appreciated. Chairperson Dickerson echoed this sentiment. Commissioner Elkins thanked Chairperson Dickerson and Commissioner Lane for their sentiments and said as a member of the Adopt a Highway Program it is nice to have recognition. Mr. Elkins said he has concerns that due to Covid, many of these groups are disbanding and he hopes in the future that they will continue to be able to provide this valuable service.

<u>Adopted Code of Conduct for Board Members</u> – Vice Chairperson Mandelaris requested that the newly adopted GCRC Code of Conduct be framed and placed in a prominent place in the boardroom. Staff stated that they would have the Code of Conduct framed and mounted in the boardroom.

Chairperson Dickerson said that he is glad to be back in the area after being out of town for the past 11 days. Mr. Dickerson said that he was able to see his family members (son and daughter-in-law) whom he has not seen for 2 years due to COVID-19. He commented that his son is a girls' basketball coach in northern California and was inducted into the Hall of Fame in Flint, MI in 2018.
