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## **Stage 4 of the Bristol Road Bridge replacement begins November 5<sup>th</sup> in Flint Township** Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission began replacement of Bristol Road Bridge over Call Drain, between Torrey Road and I-75, in Flint Township on Thursday, August 23, 2018. Phase 4 of the project will begin Monday, November 5, 2018. At this time the southbound I-75 exit ramp to eastbound Bristol Road will close to accommodate pavement repairs on eastbound Bristol Road. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour route along I-75/US-23 southbound to Hill Road eastbound, then I-75/US-23 northbound to eastbound Bristol Road. Traffic on Bristol Road will remain virtually the same with one eastbound and one westbound lane. The eastbound Bristol Road entrance ramp to southbound I-75 will remain closed at this time until guardrail can be placed on Thursday, November 8, 2018. Eastbound Bristol Road motorists are advised to continue to use the roundabout to westbound Bristol Road to the southbound I-75 entrance ramp.

The anticipated open to traffic date for I-75 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Bristol Road is November 16, 2018. Full completion of the project is November 30, 2018.
