



Genesee County Road Commission COVID-19 Test FAQ

As a GCRC employee, can I be tested for COVID-19?

*Yes, GCRC is considered an essential entity and due to recently issued State Executive Orders, COVID-19 testing has been expanded. Testing is available to **ALL** GCRC employees.*

What type of COVID-19 testing is available to me?

GCRC has partnered with a State approved medical provider that is prepared to provide viral and antibody testing:

- *A viral test tells you if you have a current infection.*
- *An antibody test tells you if you had a previous infection.*

Which type of COVID-19 testing is right for me?

Please consult with your medical healthcare provider to determine which type of testing would be most effective based on your current health conditions.

How much does the COVID-19 tests cost?

Approved COVID-19 testing is covered at 100% if provided by an authorized (State approved) medical provider— no out of pocket costs to the member, through June 30, 2020. This applies to any co-pays or office visits fees related to testing as well.

Is COVID-19 testing mandatory for GCRC employees?

No, it is not. The Human Resource Department is only coordinating efforts to ensure testing is done efficiently and timely for all active GCRC employees who are electing testing on a volunteer basis.

When can I have COVID-19 testing completed?

The approved medical provider has requested that all interested employees have a scheduled appointment date/time for testing. Please contact Monica Pearson, GCRC HR Department for availability.



Is COVID-19 testing available for my family members?

Yes, due to recently issued State Executive Orders, COVID-19 testing has been expanded. The GCRC HR Department is only coordinating testing for active GCRC employees. All others should consult with their medical healthcare professional.

When will I receive my test results?

GCRC was informed by the approved medical provider that most test results are available within 48 hours of testing date.

I was previously tested as recommended by my medical professional, if I'm retested, do I have to inform the testing provider?

Yes, based on your current medical condition, the provider may suggest antibody testing.

Can viral and antibody testing be performed during the same visit?

Yes, please consult with your medical healthcare provider to determine which type of testing would be most effective based on your current health conditions.

If I test positive, what are the next steps for me?

If a GCRC employee receives a positive test result, GCRC will expect the employee to self-quarantine for a period 14 days from the date of test, even if the employee is not displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. GCRC recommends that you consult your medical healthcare professional immediately as well as refer to the [CDC](#) guidelines on self-quarantine and caring for yourself and others.
