<u>Bid Results and Award of Contract for Grand Wailea Subdivision Nos. 1 through 3, Grand Blanc</u> <u>Charter Township</u> - In a memorandum dated January 13, 2020, staff requested the Board accept the low bid submitted by Ace-Saginaw Paving Company for the rehabilitation of Grand Wailea Subdivision Nos. 1 through 3, Grand Blanc Charter Township. <u>Compensation Summary of Non-Union Positions and Performance Evaluation Pay Increase Grid</u> – In a memorandum dated January 15, 2020, staff requested the Board approve the compensation summary of non-union positions and performance evaluation pay increase grid that ensures the GCRC has an un-bias practice when making salary decisions. (Copy of memorandum and compensation summary of non-union positions filed with official minutes.)

Human Resource Director Donna Poplar commented that the Sage Group's work on this compensation summary was very professional and trustworthy, and the work was done with integrity. Chairperson Dickerson asked if these figures in the packet were the result of Sage's study and Ms. Poplar explained that the Managing Director changed some of the compensation amounts in this evaluation. Managing Director Fred Peivandi commented that he was unclear where Sage Group derived some of their compensation amounts and additionally, when Sage Group had odd percentages such as 4.81%, he rounded up to 5%.

Maintenance Director Anthony Branch questioned why there are such large differences in the department director salaries. In addition, Mr. Branch questioned why the entry-level salary of the Maintenance Director is lower than his or her subordinates.

Chairperson Dickerson stated he did not feel comfortable voting on this agenda item today. Vice-Chairperson Kautman-Jones commented she would be willing to meet with Chairperson Dickerson, Managing Director Peivandi and Human Resource Director Poplar to discuss this further. Vice Chairperson Kautman-Jones suggested we postpone this agenda item to a later date so staff can gather more information to present to the Board.

MANAGING DIRECTOR REPORT

<u>Fringe and Overhead Rate Reduction</u> - Managing Director Fred Peivandi stated that the Road Commission's fringe benefit rate has gone down from 170% to 148%, which makes the estimated projects a little less expensive for 2020 projects. Mr. Peivandi also said we have 7.4 million dollars of our fund balance available to be allocated to county roads or bridges in addition to the 20 million dollars already set aside for projects in 2020.

<u>Audio Technology for the Boardroom</u> – Managing Director Fred Peivandi stated that the new audio equipment for the Boardroom should be set up by the February 04, 2020 Board Meeting. Operations Director Randy Dellaposta stated that the Board members as well as the public addressing the Board would have a microphone available to them.
