BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS' DECISIONS

DISCUSSION

Local Road Agreement for Construction of Morrish/Lennon Roads Roundabout, Clayton Charter Township – In a memorandum dated January 11, 2023, staff requested the Board approve the local road agreement with Clayton Charter Township for roundabout construction at the Morrish/Lennon road intersection. (Copy filed with official minutes.)

Commissioner Lane stated that the local road agreement was dated by the township, December 20, 2022, and asked staff to change it to today's date, January 17, 2023.

<u>ACTION TAKEN</u> – Motion by Ms. Lane, seconded by Mr. Arceo, to approve the local road agreement with Clayton Charter Township for roundabout construction at the Morrish/Lennon road intersection and further, authorize the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson to sign the construction agreement on behalf of the Board of County Road Commissioners.

Commissioner Arceo asked for an update on roundabouts and if the outcome has increased safety and efficiency in the county.

Mr. Johnston replied that the first roundabout the GCRC constructed was at Hill and Elms Roads, located in Mundy and Gaines Township. MDOT also constructed one at Bristol Road and I-75 in Flint Township during this time. Additional roundabouts were placed at the following locations:

- Linden and Grand Blanc, Mundy Township
- Morrish and Grand Blanc, Gaines Township
- Three on Dort Highway Extension, Grand Blanc Township
- Embury and Grand Blanc, Grand Blanc Township
- Hill and Belsay, Grand Blanc Township

Two more are being proposed for next year, one at Lapeer and Oak in Davison Township, and Lennon and Morrish in Clayton Township. The City of Fenton has also placed a roundabout by Silver Lake Road. Safety and capacity are the main reasons that roundabouts are considered. Mr. Johnston added that the Hill and Belsay Road traffic would back up between 4:30 pm to 5:00 pm and the roundabout stopped the traffic back up. Safety is also a big issue. With roundabouts, we no longer have t-type crashes; all of the crashes are sideswipe crashes, which are less severe.

Commissioner Mandelaris asked if the intersection of Lennon and Elms Road were being considered for a roundabout. Mr. Johnston replied that we applied for funding at this intersection but there were not enough accidents to warrant a roundabout.

Commissioner Arceo asked if an individual developer had plans to build subdivisions, would there be any plans to place roundabouts in these areas. Mr. Johnston answered if these developments were large enough, we could consider this but typically, subdivisions are not large enough to warrant a roundabout.

Approval of Consultant for Construction Inspection and Staking at the Reconstruction of the Genesee Road Bridge Project - In a memorandum dated January 10, 2023, staff requested the Board approve the issuance of a blanket Purchase Order to Rowe PSC for construction inspection and staking for the Genesee Road Bridge project. (Copy filed with official minutes.)

Bid Results and Award of Contract for Dye Road Curb/Driveway Repair @John's Coney Island, Flint Charter Township — In a memorandum dated January 09, 2023, staff requested the Board accept the low bid of \$104,647.00 submitted by Zito Construction, Inc., for the Dye Road Curb/Driveway Repair @ John's Coney Island in Flint Charter Township. (Copy filed with official minutes.)

Commissioner Lane asked if we knew what was the cause of the damage to the curb and gutter at this location. Mr. Johnston replied, conclusively we do not really know. We think Consumer's Energy experienced a sudden large flow of gas in their high-pressure gas line. This caused a flash freeze around the outside of the [underground] line, the frost itself expanded underneath the soil, creating a void or hole in the ground. Eventually the surface dirt was drawn into the hole [damaging the curb and gutter]. Consumers Energy said this could be a possibility of what happened. Consumers Energy placed a fix on their regulator station to prevent this from happening again and contributed \$55,000 towards the repair of the curb and gutter. Commissioner Lane said she is thankful that Consumer's Energy took some responsibility for this damage.
