GCRC Preparing for Spike in Potholes

Flint, Michigan. ---

Warmer temperatures are coming to Michigan, and with them, the arrival of pesky potholes.

Potholes are formed when water in the pavement thaws, then freezes, which expands the pavement

and makes it more susceptible to damage. Genesee County Road Commission maintenance crews

are out on the roads repairing potholes with the hot patch, a temporary fix to level out the road.

Potholes are an unfortunate reality in the state of Michigan, and with frost coming out of the

ground, they are popping up more and more each day. Our crews are making every effort to

prioritize the fixes to the more hazardous holes first.

Motorist safety is a top priority for GCRC, and we are always keeping that in mind as we deal with

the challenges that come with springtime. GCRC spends an average of \$1,500 per lane-mile per

year filling potholes.
