MDOT to detour I-69 traffic for bridge demolition

Flint, Michigan. ---

Beginning Friday, March 4 at 9 p.m., the **Michigan Department of Transportation** will close westbound I-69 at the I-475 interchange to allow for bridge demolition, weather permitting. Drivers should follow the posted detours via I-475 and Stewart Avenue. There will also be lane closures on northbound I-475 between Atherton Road and I-69. Westbound I-69 is expected to reopen on Monday, March 7 by 5 a.m. Drivers should allow additional time to reach their destination.

The work is also expected to happen the weekend of March 11. At that time, 9th Street between Grand Traverse Street and Saginaw Street will be closed. The eastbound I-69 ramps will stay open; however, they will close on March 14 until the project is complete in Mid-October.

This project is part of the Michigan Department of Transportation's \$100 million investment to rebuild more than 2 miles of I-69. It is also part of the Rebuilding Michigan program. Please contact the Michigan Department of Transportation Bay Region at (989) 754-7443 if you have questions.
