MDOT to begin I-75 resurfacing project

Grand Blanc Twp., Michigan. ---

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will begin its I-75 resurfacing project on Thursday, June 1. Work will take place between M-54 (Dort Hwy.) and US-23.

There will be lane closures and traffic shifts throughout the project. Weather permitting, northbound I-75 will be closed on June 7 and 8 from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. for joint repairs. One week later, northbound I-75 traffic will be detoured onto northbound I-475 and westbound I-69 for three days.

Southbound I-75 traffic will have nightly ramp closures during the joint repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto Hill Rd., northbound I-475, westbound I-69, and southbound I-75.

The project is expected to end in August of 2023. The work is part of a \$5.2 million investment to resurface more than four miles of I-75 in Genesee County. Please contact the Michigan Department of Transportation Bay Region at 989-754-7443 if you have questions.
